- ¹ Project-Based: Only includes royaltyfree Commercial and Research & Development use rights for BioMADE IP resulting from projects in which the member institution participates.
- ² Internal NERF: Internal Non-Exclusive Royalty Free (Internal NERF) affords the member to use institute IP to develop products, but not to commercialize the IP.
- ³ Limited C-NERF: At the submission of proposals, project team members will have an opportunity to negotiate a limited field of use exempt from the requirement to provide a Commercial Non-Exclusive Royalty Free (C-NERF) license to Platinum Members.
- ⁴Institute projects are projects funded through BioMADE project calls, as opposed to Agency-Directed Projects.
